Annual Project 54 Fundraiser

Saturday, August 28th, 2010

Project 54 is an annual fundraising event of the Wilderness Ministry Institute. The goal is to raise money to outfit indigenous youth workers with the needed gear to share the Gospel with underprivileged youth through outdoor adventure.

Project 54 is made possible by volunteer team leaders who each recruit a team to climb every 14er in the state of Colorado. On August 28th our 54 team leaders will lead a team to the summit of all 54 fourteen thousand foot peaks in Colorado. Each team leader gathers a team of friends, co-workers, family members, etc. to climb with them. Every person raises pledges on their team's behalf (think of it as a walk-o-thon on steroids). This year we are asking each team to raise a minimum of \$1000 (for example 10 members could ask 10 donors for \$10 each). For friendly competition, all the 54 teams donation levels will be tracked at www.project54.org so that everyone can know where their team stands.

Rules

1. Participants may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets and checks need to be mailed and post marked no later than the day of the event, Saturday, August 28th 2010.**
2. Pledges can also be made online by visiting **www.project54.org**. Please remember to select the correct peak on the drop down menu. All major credit cards are accepted.
3. In order for a donation to count for the fundraising competition online pledges must be given by August 28th, 2010 and checks must be postmarked by August 28th, 2010. All other donations are accepted but will not count towards the fundraising competition.
4. After all donations have been tallied prizes will be awarded for the top three fundraising teams.
